Leader's Checklist for Minors on an ADK Glens Falls-Saratoga Chapter Outing

This checklist is an aid to leaders in carrying out the chapter's policy on unaccompanied minors on outings. For simplicity, this checklist uses the term parent to refer the minor's parent or guardian.

Before the	e outing:
	ontact the parent and provide him or her with the Release of Liability for Minor and the uthorization by Person in Parental Relation for Emergency Medical Care forms.
	onfirm that the minor is at least 15 years old; alternatively, confirm that the minor is at least 12 ears old if you know the minor.
	etermine that both the parent and the minor understand the nature of the outing and that the inor is sufficiently prepared, both physically and with equipment, for the outing.
Co	onfirm that the parent will accompany the minor to the meeting place for the outing.
	onfirm that a parent will be available by telephone during the entire outing. Obtain a telephone umber at which a parent can be contacted during the outing.
	onfirm that the parent will be available to pick up the minor at the meeting place during the stire potential return window or that the minor will drive home at the end of the outing.
	scuss any medical issues with the parent. The parent may e-mail the filled out medical care rm. Make sure the parent knows that the minor must carry a medical insurance ID card.
At the out	ting meeting place:
	otain the signed release of liability for minor form directly from the parent. Have the minor ad parent sign in on the ADK release form (the one that everyone signs) as well.
pa	otain the filled out and signed medical care form if not previously received. Confirm with the arent the preferred telephone contact number (this should be on the medical form). Take the rms with you on the outing.
Co	onfirm that the minor has his or her medical insurance ID card.
	onfirm the range of arrival times with the parent and the arrangements for the minor to get ome.
After the	outing:
Re	eturn the medical form to the parent or minor, or securely destroy it.
Ma	ake sure the minor is picked up or drives away.
Ma	ail the minor release of liability form to the Outings Chair.
